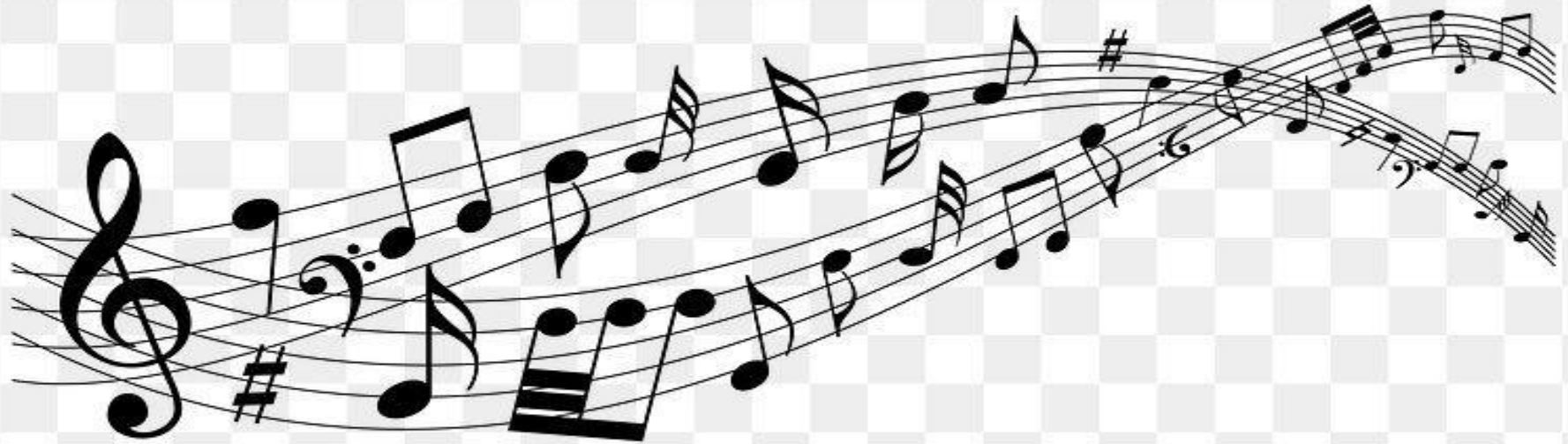

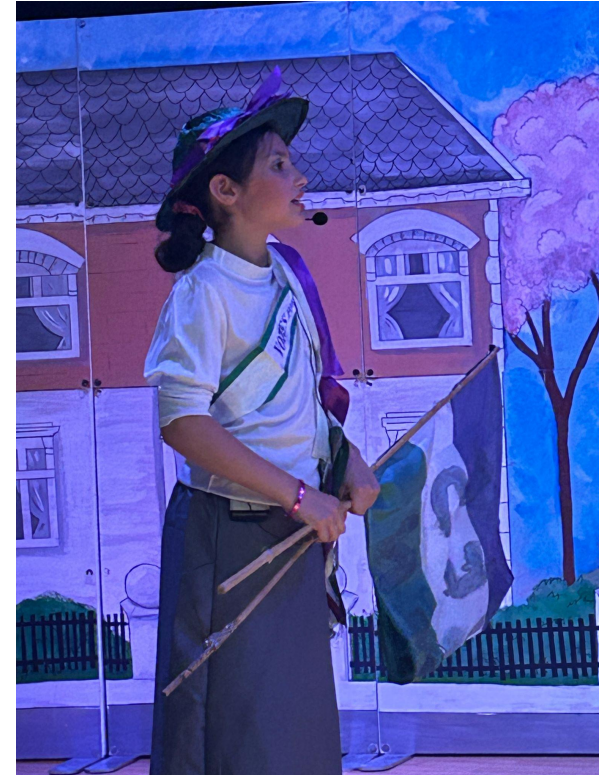

Priorities for 2024-25

1. With Curriculum lead and IT lead, embed opportunities for using technology to integrate music into the full curriculum.
2. EYFS - Develop the system of assessment to record where children are in line with expectations for music.
3. Develop metacognition in music so that staff who team teach alongside the specialist can interact and develop these strategies throughout the lesson.
4. Improve the quality and quantity of musical instruments so that class music making is more accessible and the children use a range of instruments.
